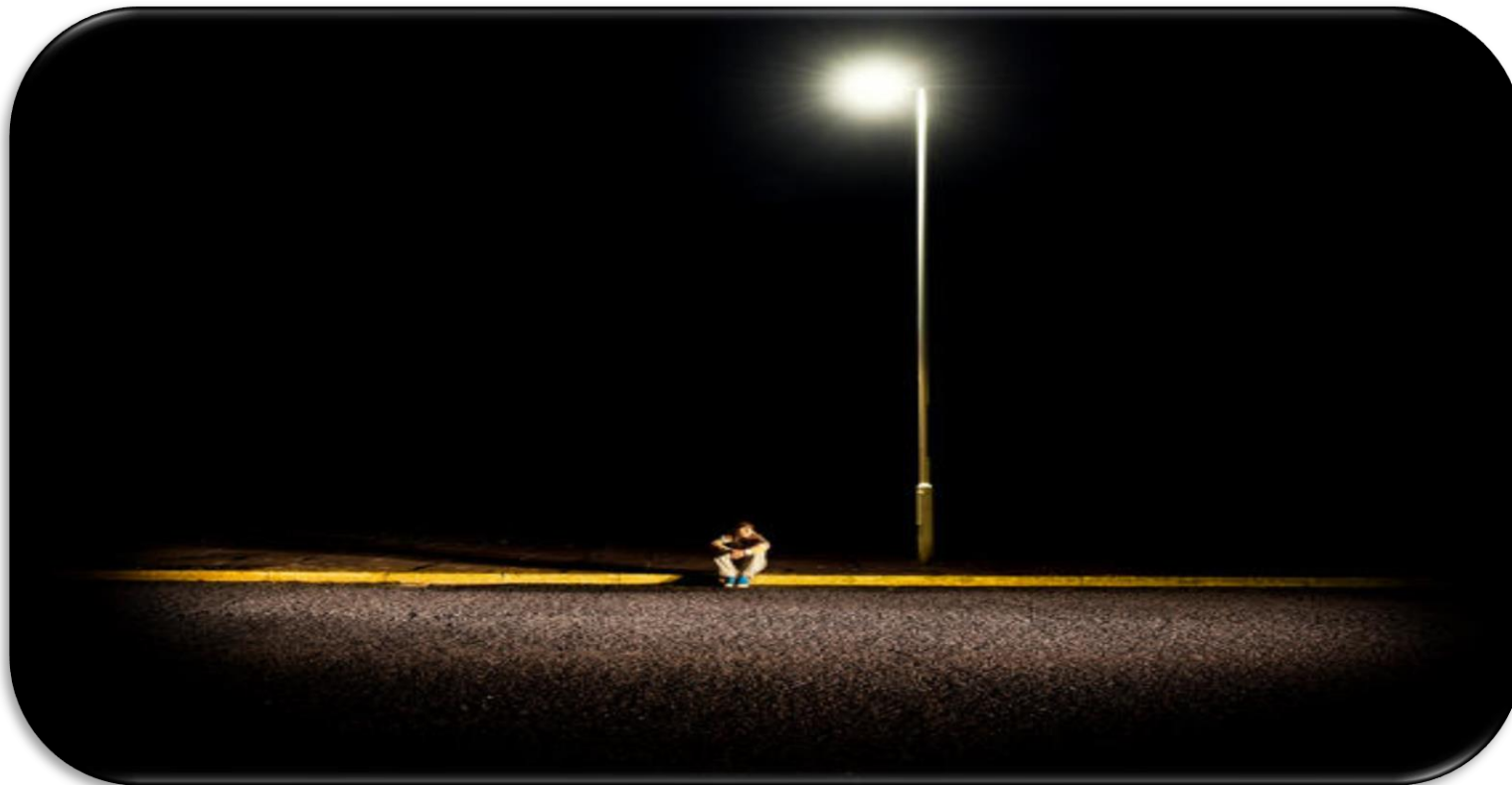

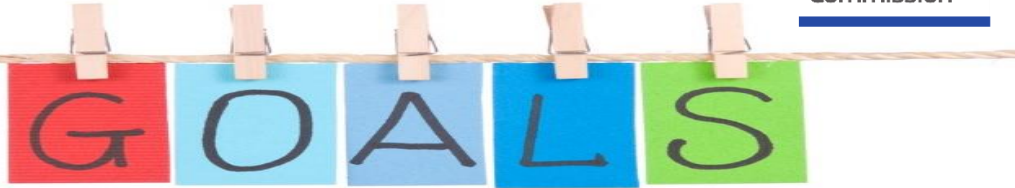

Find business opportunities in the calls for tenders managed by public bodies and agencies



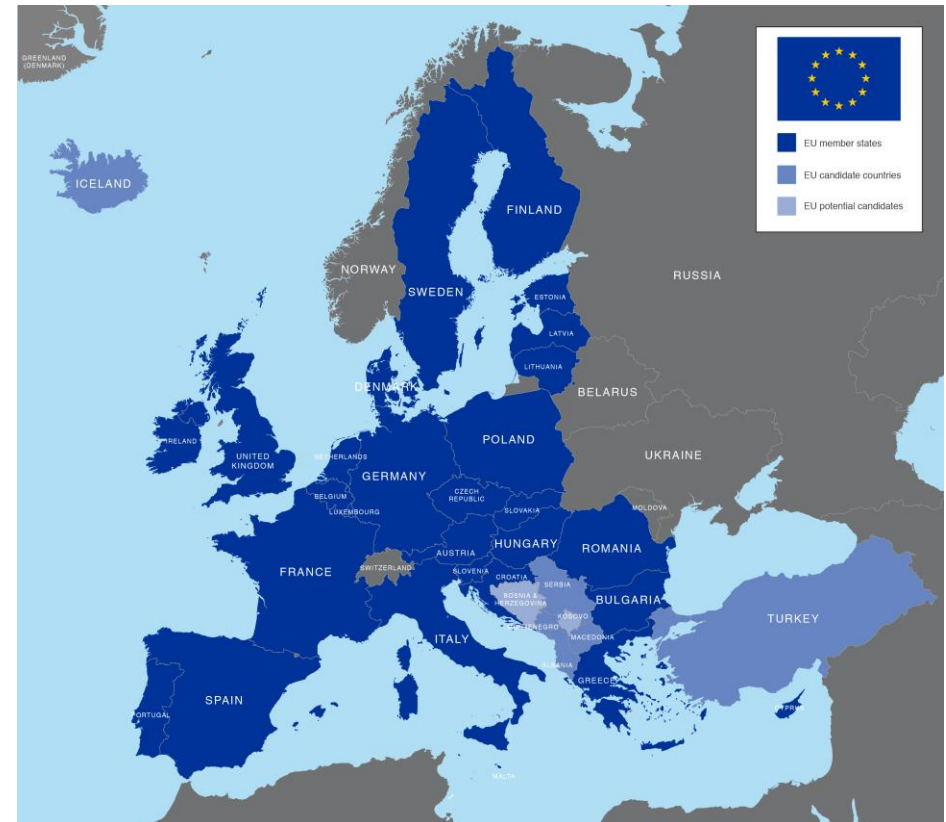
Goals for Engagement in EU Frameworks:

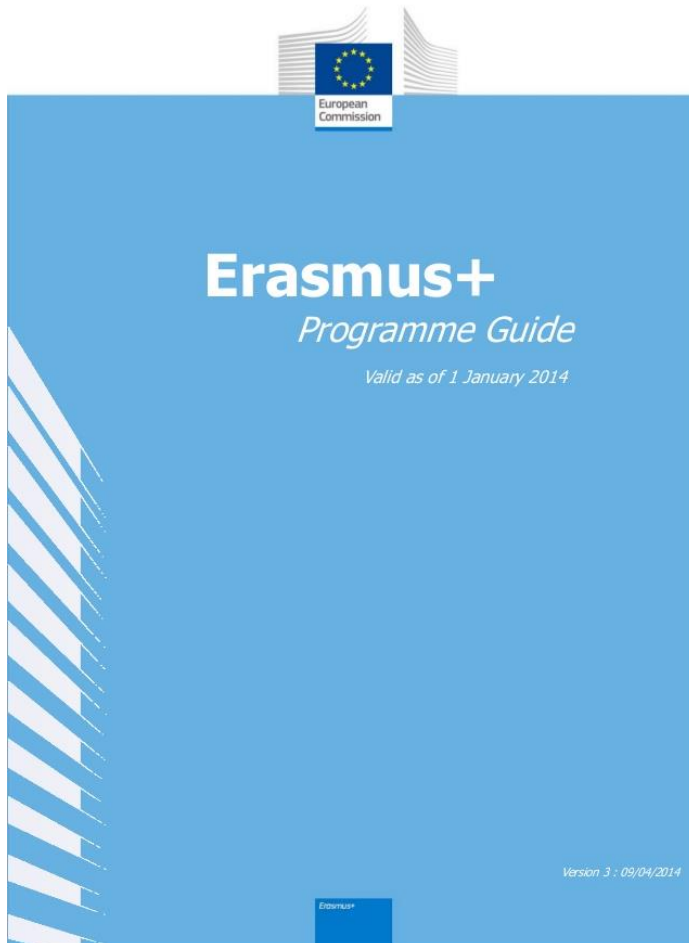
Project Planning

Consider the exact deadline for the project registration and start to plan your project months before





Preparation:

- ➡ Read the program guide (with all footnotes ...)
- ➡ Consider the rules for contributors
- ➡ Consider rules and principles for project registration in each part
- ➡ Study the former related projects and prepare the proposal according to them
- ➡ The process of selecting projects and evaluation

- Prepare a realistic and detailed budget for your project
- Read well about coverable and unacceptable costs
- Double-Check the amounts again before finalizing proposed total budget

Important notes in proposal design:

- ✓ Start your proposal with confidence and strength
 - ✓ Consider the balance of proposal and cover all subjects in evaluation process
 - ✓ Your proposal should complement the previous and future scientific endeavors as well as add new creative aspects to the previous topics.
- 
- ✓ Explain the organization of the research team and your partners in the implementation of the project
 - ✓ Select the title Carefully and give enough time to choose an attractive, comprehensive and relevant one
 - ✓ Make the project goals accurate and transparent
 - ✓ Your writing matters...!
 - ✓ Proposals should be realistic in terms of the timing of project implementation

Four Pillar of a Proposal

- There should be **only** one main and high level goal in the project
- The consortium must be competent and capable
- Organization, implementation and resources management should be described
- The work-plans must be feasible, realistic, target-oriented, and transparent
- Describe the results of the project and how the dissemination strategy works?

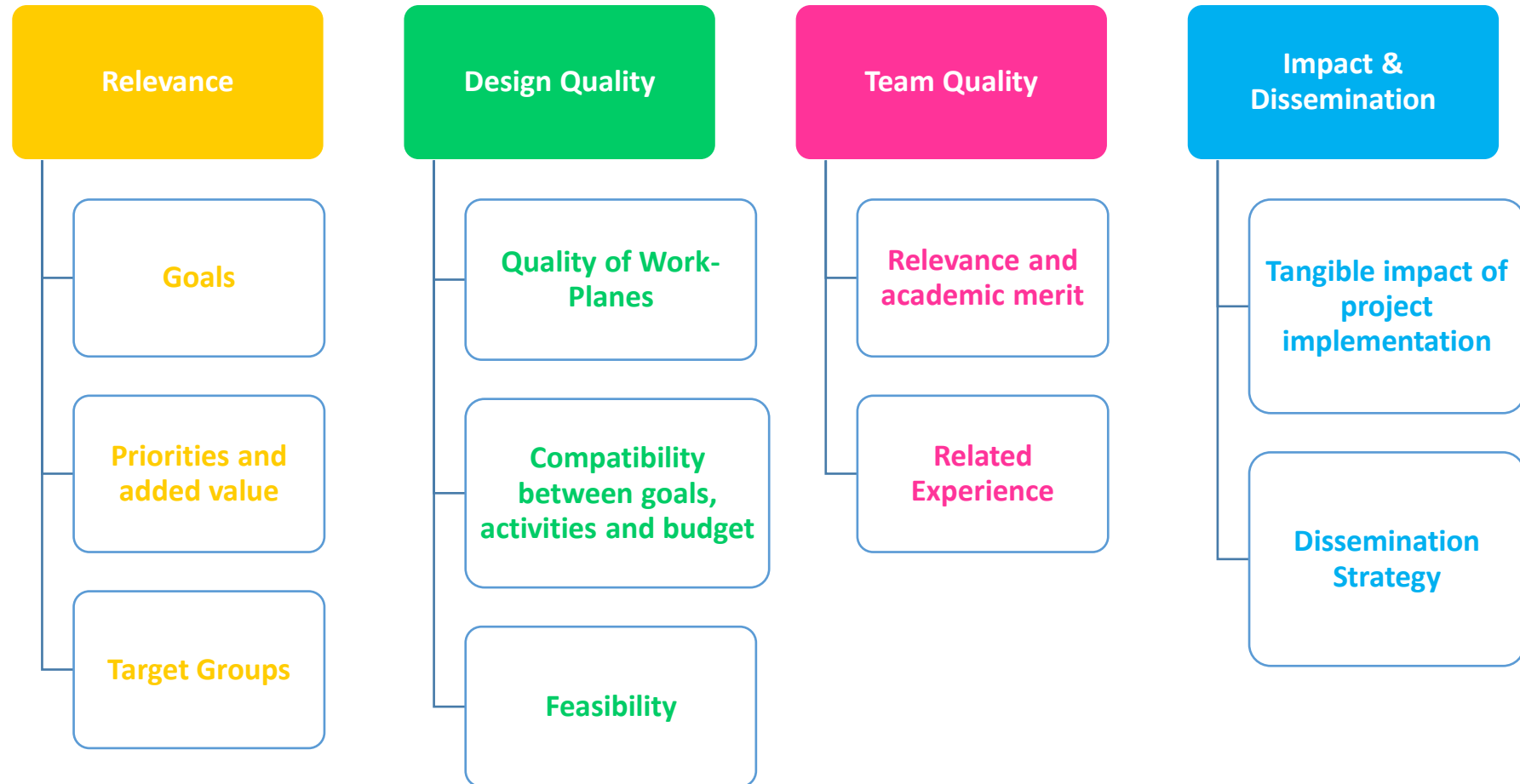

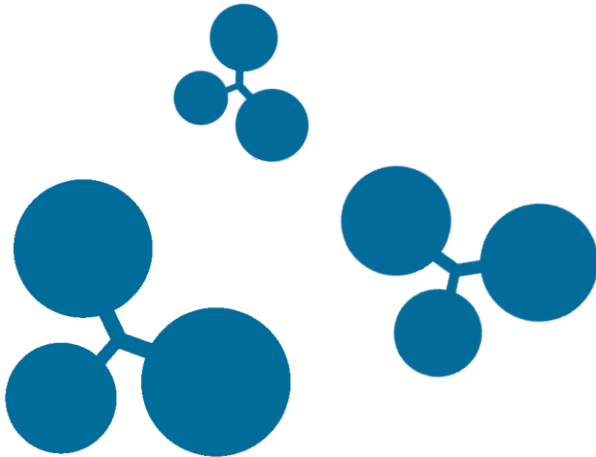
